

- You have brain metastases which were treated by sterotactic radiation or surgery within the last 3-6 weeks
- You are able to complete a brain MRI, lumbar puncture, bloodwork, and provide a pre-enrollment brain tumor sample if available
- You live near or are able to travel to Bethesda, MD
