Questions to Ask...

if you find a lump in your breast

- 1. Can you refer me to an accredited mammography facility for a mammogram?
- 2. Can this lump be aspirated (fluid or cells removed with a needle)?
- 3. What about a biopsy? Why? Why not? What type?
- 4. Can you refer me to a doctor who specializes in breast problems for further tests and/or treatment?
- 5. Would ultrasound be recommended?
- 6. What non-cancerous conditions can cause breast lumps?
- *→ Helpful hint:* If a waiting period is advised, consider getting a second opinion from a specialist.
