## Are you Postmenopausal? Do you have Dense Breasts?

If so, you may be eligible to participate!



### Why is this study being done?

Research suggests that women with dense breasts are more likely to develop breast cancer. This study will test if anti-inflammatory drugs are able to reduce breast density and help us understand why breast density is linked to breast cancer development. This study is sponsored by the National Cancer Institute.

### Who is eligible for the study?

You may be eligible if ...

- You're postmenopausal
- Have dense breasts
- You're able to take drugs like aspirin, Motrin, or Advil
- Have a history of breast cancer or are at higher-than-average risk for developing breast cancer



### What will be asked of me if I consent to be in the study?

- Take a pill twice a day for 12 months
- Provide a sample of urine and blood
- Undergo non-contrast breast MRI Imaging (~ 15-minute scan)
- Optional breast biopsy
- There is no payment or cost for participating
