

The STOP breast cancer clinical trial – <u>Stony Brook Medicine</u> Are you Postmenopausal? Do you have Dense Breasts?

Research suggests that women with dense breasts are more likely to develop breast cancer. This study will test if anti-inflammatory drugs are able to reduce breast density and help us understand why breast density is linked to breast cancer development.
